For BC-called Lawyers (Law Society of British Columbia)

The Conference qualifies for up to 11.25 credits. It is to be noted however that the following sessions do NOT qualify for CPD credit: P1, W12, W13, W15, W16, P5.

Report on the LSBC Portal as attendance at the *CAA/IPEBLA Joint Conference 2012* among courses provided by the *International Pension and Employee Benefits Lawyers Association*.

For Ontario-called Lawyers (Law Society of Upper Canada)

The content of session W11 on April 23 (Communication and Professionalism) and session W15 (Recharging and Stress Management) on April 24 each qualifies for 1 hour of Professionalism or New Member credit. Report on the LSUC Portal under Professionalism Programs with program provider as *Delee Fromm Consulting*. Note that a separate entry must be made for attendance at each session.

The remaining sessions of the Conference qualify for up to a total of 10.25 hours of Substantive credit for Ongoing Members but only actual attendance time at the education sessions is to be reported. Report on the LSUC Portal under Substantive Programs with program provider as *International Pension and Employee Benefits Lawyers Association*.

For Quebec-called Lawyers (Barreau du Québec)

Since the Conference is partially accredited by the LSUC and otherwise qualifies under the LSUC Regime, it is automatically recognized by the Barreau du Québec and qualifies for up to 12.25 MCE credits. Report actual attendance time at the education sessions under activity number 10017364.
