Kurt N. Schacht, JD, CFA, is the Managing Director, Centre for Financial Market Integrity of CFA Institute (formerly known as the Association for Investment Management and Research®). He is responsible for all aspects of the Centre's efforts to develop, promulgate, and maintain the highest ethical standards for the investment community including CFA Institute Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct, Global Investment Performance Standards®, CFA Institute Research Objectivity Standards, and CFA Institute Soft Dollar Standards®. He directs the Centre's efforts to represent the views of investment professionals to standard setters, regulatory authorities, and legislative bodies worldwide on issues that affect the practice of financial analysis and investment management, education, and licensing requirements for investment professionals, and the efficiency of global financial markets.

Mr. Schacht is a member of the newly created Investor Advisory Committee of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). He is currently serving a two year term as member of the PCAOB's (Public Company Accounting Oversight Board) standing advisory group. He also served on the Advisory Committee for Smaller Public Companies to the SEC, the Expert's Group for Principles for Responsible Investment of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), and the Proxy Committee of the International Corporate Governance Network (ICGN). He was the New York Society of Security Analysts 2004 Volunteer of the Year. Mr. Schacht received a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemistry and a JD from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He attained the Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA®) designation in 1998.
